

FADE IN:

INT. KITCHEN DINER - MID-MORNING (Lazy Simon)

SIMON is wearing a dressing gown and sits at a table eating cereal slowly. A copy of a technical essay lies in front of him, entitled "A 50W Laser for Less Than £100". Simon's elder sister AMANDA is doing the washing up. LS1



AMANDA

So how many jobs have you applied for this week?

SIMON

Same as last week and the week before.

AMANDA

University's a lot more expensive than you think. I'm still paying off my student loan.

(pretending to be surprised)
Oh, didn't you get a bursary,


AMANDA


INT. DOMESTIC GARAGE - DAY (Laser Burning) Establishing shot of Garage

LB1




Simon adjusts a home-made piece of equipment on a workbench comprising a steel tube 3" in diameter bolted parallel to a plank of wood, lying horizontally.

Each end of the tube is covered with a glass plate. He adjusts screws to bring these mirrors into alignment. A powerful beam of blue light is emitted from one end and from the gaps between the tube and the mirrors. The beam illuminates a bright spot on a sheet of white painted hardboard leaning against the wall. A small trail of smoke begins. Simon switches off the laser.



Simon lays a finger on the spot slowly and then snatches it away quickly as it burns him. $$\operatorname{LB4}$$




INT. KITCHEN DINER - LATER (Chris Arrives)


Amanda is still working in the kitchen. Simon is no longer there. There is a ring of the doorbell.



Amanda goes to answer it.



The caller is CHRIS, the same age as Simon but looking tougher and more worldly wise.



CHRIS Hi, Amanda, is Simon in?

Hi Chris. Yes, he's in the garage working on that Laser thing of yours.

Well he's up to something. Try and talk some sense into him if you can.



INT. DOMESTIC GARAGE - DAY (Chris Confronts Simon)


There is a ${\tt HAMMERING}$ on the garage door.

SIMON

It's open. CS1



The garage door opens and CHRIS walks in.



Chris walks up to the workbench at the back of the garage. When he sees the laser he looks angry.



CHRIS

You idiot. I never said you could use my laser design to actually build one!


SIMON

Amanda hears the argument beginning and hurries out to the garage.







CHRIS

Amanda opens the garage door.



Chris and Simon each make a grab for the laser. The laser fires and the beam catches Amanda on the arm. She pulls back and covers her arm with her hand.



Argh!

We see an expression of alarm on Simon's face.

CHRIS

Amanda are you ok?

CS3

Chris hurries over to her.

AMANDA

You've burnt me! You boys are as bad as each other. Just leave me alone.

CS7

Amanda runs back to the house.

CHRIS

You're unbelievable. Don't you care what you've just done to your Sister? You could easily have really hurt her.

CS3

SIMON

I didn't mean to she just barged in.

CS1

CHRIS

You shouldn't be messing with any of this stuff. You've got no goggles, no proper casing, it's really dangerous. I wish I'd never given you my paper to proof read.

CS3

Chris strides out, BANGING the garage door. Simon smirks. (CS1) He reaches up to a shelf and pulls down Chris's paper, the same one that he was reading at breakfast, tears it in half, and drops it in the recycling box.

EXT. BACK GARDEN AT SIMON'S HOUSE - AFTERNOON (Shooting Down The Plane)

It is hot and sunny with a cloudless sky. Simon has the laser which now has an optical sight. It is plugged into the mains by means of an extension lead from the garage.

He points it at various objects.

SIMON


(imitating the lasers in sci-fi movies)
Pew! Pew!

The DRONING of a light aircraft can be heard. Simon looks up and sees it overhead at 3000 feet. He squats down and looks through the eyepiece. Simon practices tracking the plane. The plane swings wildly across the cross-hairs in the viewfinder at first but then become more stable as he learns the technique. He presses the trigger. A pulse of bright blue light is emitted from the gaps between the covers, and a blue ray is emitted from the end of the unit up into the sky. At that instant, the DRONING of the light plane suddenly INCREASES IN PITCH as the engine races. Looking up, we see it lose control and spiral down to the ground. As it approaches ground level, we hear the SCREAMING NOISE caused by turbulence over the aerofoils as they reach their maximum design speed, and then a LOUD BANG as the plane impacts the ground and explodes.


Simon looks horrified and stares upwards, rooted to the spot.

INT. KITCHEN - DAY (Amanda Is A Witness)

Amanda hears the bang and looks out of the window.



She sees the expression on Simon's face. She looks around at the nearby houses and gardens. But on a weekday afternoon, no-one is about. She hurries outside.



EXT. BACK GARDEN AT SIMON'S HOUSE - AFTERNOON (Amanda Takes Charge)

A large column of black smoke rises in the distance.

AMANDA

You muppet, what have you done?

(pause)

Give me one good reason why I shouldn't call the police right now.

ATC1



Simon is too shocked to reply. He looks on the point of breaking down in tears.


AMANDA (continuing)

Look, perhaps that was nothing to do with you.

Simon looks hopeful.

ATC2



AMANDA (CONTINUING)

Ray guns are for comic books. I don't believe you did shoot it down. And even if you did, tell yourself that you didn't. (pause)

Now pack that laser away out of sight. And put it out of your mind. Concentrate on normal things, like mowing the lawn and fixing your bike — and getting a job!

ATC1

After a few moments, he recovers his composure and unplugs the laser from the extension lead.


The distant sound of BELLS and SIRENS can be heard.

INT. LOFT ENTRY AT SIMON'S HOUSE - DAY (Conceal The Evidence) Simon takes the laser, wrapped in an old sheet, up into the loft and puts it in a far corner.



INT. DINING ROOM AT SIMON'S HOUSE - EVENING (Meet The Parents)
Simon and Amanda's MOTHER is preparing a meal. Simon and
Amanda are sitting down. Amanda has bandaged her burnt
arm.


Amanda's FATHER walks in.






Simon and Amanda look at each other. MTP3

No, but I heard the bang. When I looked out the smoke was just appearing.

Didn't you think of going to take a look?

SIMON

Don't be daft! I heard the sirens. They wouldn't let anyone near. Getting in their way would be stupid.

FATHER

My my! Mr Sensible!

INT. SIMON'S BEDROOM - EVENING (Chris On The Mobile)

Simon is googling the plane crash. His mobile phone RINGS. He looks at the display and hesitates before answering.

This scene not storyboarded as shots will depend on location.

SIMON

Hi Chris.

CHRIS

(filtered)

What do you know about the plane crash?

SIMON

(trying to sound nonchalant) Only what I've heard on the news.

CHRIS

(filtered)

Tell me Simon! Did you configure the laser in pulse mode? Was it your doing?

SIMON

My laser can blister paintwork, not shoot planes out of the sky.

CHRIS

(filtered)

Your laser. I'll remember that.

EXT. PLANE CRASH SITE - DAY (Crash Site Investigation)

Air Accident Investigators make a painstaking search through the wreckage looking for clues.



INT. HALLWAY AT SIMON'S HOUSE - DAY (Local Paper Scene)


Simon is sitting at the dining room table. MUSIC can be heard from a radio tuned to a local station. The local paper drops onto the mat. Simon glances at it but ignores it.



We see the headline "Plane Crash Misses Shops".



Amanda walks downstairs and picks up the paper.



After recognising the headline, she puts it down in front of Simon.



AMANDA

Don't you care?

SIMON

About what?

AMANDA

That plane crash! It could just as easily come down right on top of us.

SIMON

Well it didn't.

RADIO ANNOUNCER

(filtered)

In our local news, police now report that the light aircraft which crashed yesterday was believed to be piloted by two men wanted in connection with a raid on a jewelery store yesterday.

INT. AIR ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION BOARD - DAY (AAIB Look At Wing)

Office in the premises of the AAIB. Part of the spotlessly clean hanger in which aircraft are dismantled and inspected is visible. An enthusiastic young engineer is working at her desk. Her manager approaches.

MANAGER

Saw your email - "crazy"
doesn't begin to describe it.

ENGINEER

Well, it might just be crazy enough to be true.

MANAGER

Are you sure the aileron was jammed?

ENGINEER

The cable was spot-welded to the airframe. It couldn't have been like that before loss of control.

MANAGER

Yes, but... lasers?


ENGINEER

The metal around the hole in the wing has been melted, but further away it hasn't. I don't know of anything else that could do that so fast. I could try to calculate where on the ground it came from, based on the aircrafts heading and the angle the ray entered the wing ...

MANAGER

No, leave this with me. But let me have a full report - just the facts.

Spotlessly clean aircraft hanger in which the crashed plane has been dismantled. A wing section lies upside down on tressels. A TECHNICIAN wearing overalls is examining it. A MANAGER wearing a suit is trying to move the aileron.



MANAGER
This aileron appears undamaged but it's frozen solid. Let's take a look at the cable.

AAIB_1

The Technician tugs at a cable inside the wing.



TECHNICIAN

It wont move!


S_AAIB_2

He looks through a burnt hole in the undersurface of the wing.

TECHNICIAN (contiuing)

I can see where it's jammed! It seems to be spot welded to the airframe. It couldn't have been like that when the aircraft was flying.

The Technician rubs his hand over the wings surface.



TECHNICIAN Well the surrounding area is undamaged, so it wasn't




MANAGER

Oh, so the pilot had enemies who shot him down with a raygun? This isn't an episode of Captain Scarlet.

Technician holds a ballpoint pen through the burn hole in the wing pointing at the weld on the cable.



TECHNICIAN

I can't tell you, but based on the aircraft's heading and the angle that the ray entered the wing, we can estimate where on the ground it came from.

INT. SIMON AND AMANDA'S HOUSE - DAY (Simon Drunk)


Amanda walks outside to peg out washing. She hears a SCUFFLING from the garden shed.



Looking inside, she sees Simon drinking whisky straight from the bottle.




Behind him is his bike, in pieces. Simon looks guilty and makes a futile attempt to hide the bottle.



She goes inside the shed and closes the door. Amanda holds out her hand for the bottle, as if to confiscate it.



Simon hands it over in resignation. She sits down beside \lim , at the same level.



She takes a swig of whisky and hands it back. Simon is shocked at the change in behaviour.

INT. KITCHEN DINER - EARLY MORNING (Simon Goes To Work)

Amanda is in her dressing gown, while Simon is getting ready to go to work. He is looking smart, wearing a casual

suit, and enjoying playing the part of the aggressive young business man.



AMANDA

Toast? SGTW1

SIMON

No thanks, I'm a bit late for work.

SGTW2



AMANDA

It's great that you've got a job.

(pause)

Simon?

SGTW2



SIMON

Yes? SGTW3

AMANDA

Could you take the recycling boxes out please? I'm still

SIMON


I'm in a bit of a rush. Let's leave that till next week.

Amanda looks appalled by his unfeeling attitude to her (SGTW2).


EXT. SIMON AND AMANDA'S HOUSE - DAY (Recycling Boxes)

Amanda goes to the garage to fetch the recycling boxes. The lawn has been cut, and Simon's bike is outside, assembled and complete.




She finds the paper box too heavy to lift. She takes some

of the papers off the top and puts them beside the box, leaving the lid off as she will come back for the extra papers. She part carries and part drags the box to the end of the garage driveway.



We see two men in suits walk up the road. We can tell that they are policemen. Their eyes are taking in everything. Seeing Amanda, instead of going to the front door, they talk directly to her.



The man who speaks takes a warrant card from his jacket pocket and shows it to her.

RBH SOWN POV A

FIRST MAN

Good morning madam. We're police officers investigating the plane crash which occurred near here. Have you seen any suspicious activity in the area recently?

(pause)

A vehicle parked that you don't recognise, or people coming and going that you haven't seen before?

No, its always quiet round here, no trouble at all.


